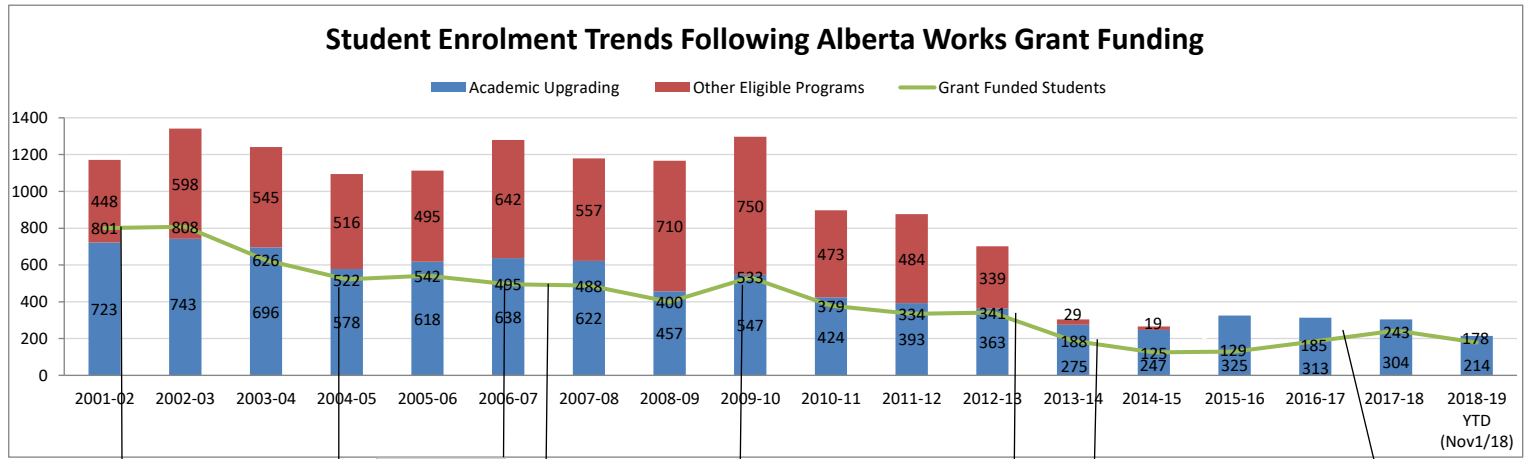

Relevant social policy changes

On/off reserve funding implemented

4 year out rule implemented and diploma programs made eligible

On/off reserve amended to allow non status to leave reserve for training

INAC allows benefits for when leave the reserve

Diploma programs no longer funded, Mobius Implemented

Based on AHS projected budget decreases.
-Work Foundations 31%
-Integrated /Occupational Training 16%
-and other eligible remaining constant

As of April 1, 2014, only programs less than 12 weeks and Academic Upgrading are eligible for grant funding

As of July 2017 Portage began participating in a pilot project, the Foundational Learning Supports Grant, that enabled us to disburse the funds directly to approved students.
