"I thought about quitting, but because of the sacrifices that my kids had to make with not seeing me, I decided to keep going. I couldn't have done it without the instructors Lyla Allan, Tracy Orr and Janet Auger - they helped me stay focused. I have been told that I can be intimidating and I had a real fear of scaring people rather than helping them. The instructors kept it real for me and accepted me for who I was and treated me like everybody else."

Trevor graduated from Portage College in 2017 and is now a Youth Family Counselor in central Alberta who works with at-risk youth as well as families, helping them re-unite. "I can relate with most of my clients. I tell them what you see is what you get, and that I will do my best to help. I am proud that I have accomplished every goal I set out to do in my life."
