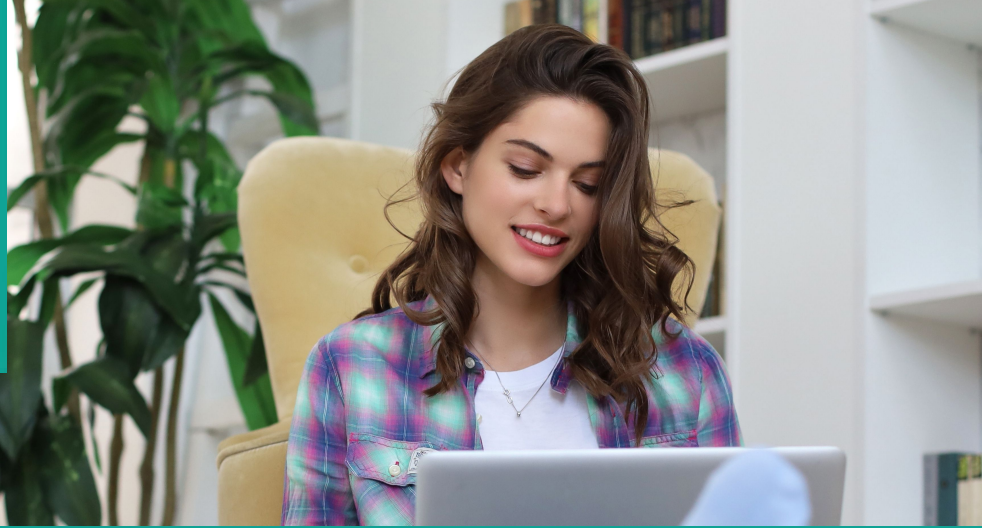

UNIVERSITY COURSES FOR GRADE 12 STUDENTS



DID YOU KNOW? Grade 12 high school students are eligible for one FREE course per semester with Portage College!

BUSL 261 – Learn the basics of business law including how the legal system works, business partnerships, obligations and property law.

COMM 121 - This is the communication process that teaches effective and persuasive business writing techniques as well as presentation skills using visuals.

DRMA101 – Dramatic Process I: An introduction to the process of acting and dramatic form through the process of improvisation (Cold Lake campus only).

ECON 186 - Microeconomics. Learn how supply, demand and price determine how decisions are made by the market system, individuals and firms.

HEED 105 – Personal Health and Wellness: Introduction to the physical, social, mental, occupational, emotional, environmental and spiritual dimensions of personal health and wellness.

HIST 211 – An Introduction to the Study of Canadian History: Confederation to the Present.

MARK 166 – Introductory course on the fundamental principles and concepts of marketing.

MATH100 – Introduction to Calculus I. The methods and applications of single variable calculus.

MATH 117 - The fundamentals and concepts of business mathematics. Students come away with abilities to solve practical business problems in marketing and finance.

ORGB 193 - Organizational behavior is the study of what people think, feel and do - ultimately affecting self, others and an organization's bottom line.

PSYC 104 – Introductory Psychology: The history of psychological science, psychological research methods, the brain and nervous system, learning, perception, consciousness, thought and language.

SOCI 101 – Introduction to Sociology: Introductory overview of sociological concepts, perspectives, processes and institutions in a Canadian context.
