ABOUT THE POSITION

- Understand and implement the skills being taught.
- Monitor all inventory/tools/equipment used as part of the teaching project.
- Use organization and time management skills to plan and prioritize.

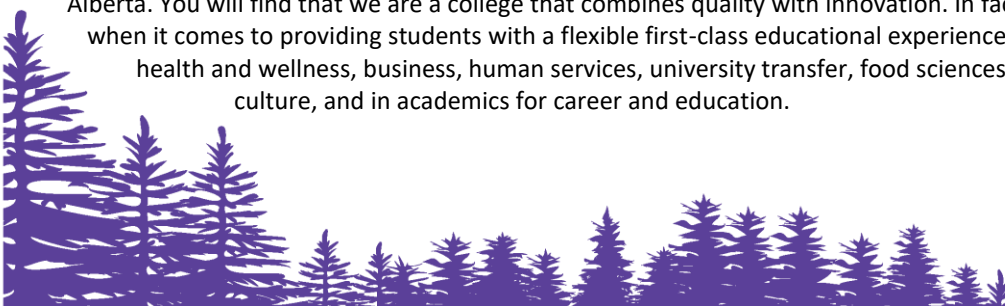
QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE
