ABOUT THE POSITION

Reporting to the Supervisor of Campus Security, this role has the primary responsibility to ensure the College campus is secured internally and externally, to respond to emergency situations and provide frontline student assistance when problems arise.

Responsibilities include:

- Provide ongoing support to students and staff, and monitor College property.
- Assist students as problems arise, respond to issues of personal safety, assist with student intake and checkout, lock and open college buildings, monitor facility equipment and systems and complete required documentation.
- Work days, evenings, and weekends, and travel to other Portage College campus locations and provide campus security responsibilities at those locations.
